Thank you for inquiring about the State approved qualified medication administration class with Senior Housing Options. We are a nonprofit company with a mission to provide quality affordable housing and services to seniors of low and moderate income.

ALL STUDENTS MUST PRE- REGISTER. The cost of the class is \$55.00 and money orders must be made out to C.D.P.H.E. (Colorado Dept. of Public Health & Environment). Please mail the money order and registration form before the class as it must be received at Senior Housing Options by the 15th of the month.

You will be registered for a particular class when your payment and registration form is received on a first come, first served basis.

Only assisted living company checks or personal money orders from the students will be accepted. **No cash or personal checks will be accepted at any time.** The cost for the retake of the exam is \$30.00 if you do not pass the exam with 85%.

All class participants will need to bring to class a "photo ID" for proof of identification. The following are accepted: Colorado Driver's License, Colorado ID card, Military ID, Tribal enrollment card, current passport, or current student ID card.

I am limited to 15 students in each class and space is reserved when your payment is received. If you are unable to attend a class that you have registered for, please contact me as soon as possible to allow someone else to take your place.

The study guide will be sent after your registration for class has been received. Please study the material before the class. Giving the right medication to the right resident at the right time is part of the basic concept of safe medication administration.

The medication class is usually held on the fourth Thursday of each month from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. and the next day is reserved for testing. The practical exam is on Friday which will actually test your skills in giving medication according to the medication record. Please come to the class on time and be well rested. The practical exam lasts 6-8 hours.

Lunch is on your own both days and you will have one hour. You are welcome to bring your own lunch and I will provide water and coffee, as well as, a microwave to heat your entrée.
