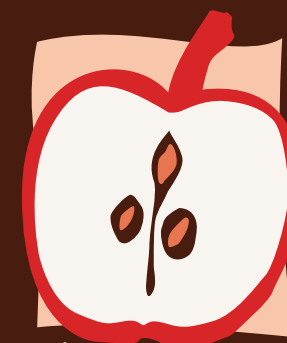

Located in Longmont, beautifully landscaped grounds draw residents outside to walk or sit and relax with friends and family. And in the summertime, residents eat items grown in their own garden.

A range of daily activities stimulate a joy for new things. A decade-long wellness initiative provides an education program with interactive lectures on nutrition, alternate healing, mental health and exercise. Residents are excited to learn about new ways they can live productive, engaged lives and take control of their own health. And Cinnamon Park is close to shopping, churches, medical facilities and a convenient bus line.

NEARLY THREE DECADES OF COMPASSIONATE SERVICE

Cinnamon Park is owned by Senior Housing Options (SHO), a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit charitable organization. Focused on working with older adults with low and moderate incomes, SHO operates seven assisted living residences and seven subsidized housing properties. In all locations, SHO staff is thoroughly screened and selected for its dedication to providing loving care to our residents. All of our assisted living facilities are licensed by the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and certified for Medicaid reimbursement.



FRIENDSHIPS INDEPENDENCE SUPPORT



Assisted living is very different from a nursing home. It provides a place where individuals can get the extra help they need to live life to the fullest. Residents can choose to relax at home or take advantage of the shops, restaurants and businesses on Longmont's Main Street.

Support services include nutritionally home-cooked meals, snacks, housekeeping and laundry services. Medication monitoring is provided according to individual need. Overall health care services are coordinated in an atmosphere that promotes personal independence and choice with a sense of safety and well-being.
